FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK



Dear Parents,

What a wonderful start to the 2019 School Year. Welcome to our new year 1's pictured above with their teachers. It was clear our students at Inglewood PS were happy to return to school after a wonderful vacation to reconnect with their school friends. Visiting the classrooms this week, I could see our students were rested but excited to meet their new teacher and settle into their new classrooms.

Staff were busy last week participating in professional learning about the latest research related to lesson design and Explicit Teaching, reviewing the Aboriginal Cultural Framework, a demonstration workshop for the writing process and using software with the new interactive TV's being installed throughout the school.

During the school holidays all classrooms which had blackboards have been upgraded with new whiteboards. The 12 remaining classrooms who had older interactive whiteboard technology will be upgraded with the latest technology next week. These have been purchased through funds accrued in the school reserve accounts used to upgrade technology resources.

I encourage all families to be involved in your child's school life, through the P&C, parent liaison representative, School Board, class social events and play dates. Inglewood has a wonderful school community so please join in and become part of it.

If you have any questions at any stage throughout the year about the school or your child, the first port of call is your child's class teacher.

Some classes ask for parent help throughout the year. I encourage you to volunteer to be a class helper when you can. You and your child will love it!

On the 22 February, the Welcome Picnic is the first P&C event for the year, welcoming new and existing families to our school. Please join us at this event and meet new friends and other families in your child's new class.

In the next 3 weeks, all class teachers will be holding a class meeting where they will share with parents what is planned for the year. School learning priorities, communication and class expectations will be discussed. If you are unable to attend this meeting, I encourage you to contact your child's teacher to discuss the information presented at this session.

We have three new staff joining us at Inglewood Primary School this year. I would like to welcome Margie Best in the role as Deputy Principal this term, Edith Scrafton-Savage who is teaching in PP1 and Frank Guillaume who has been employed this year to support our technologies infrastructure. Frank will be

working one day a week across several local primary schools to support the management of our school devices. We welcome our new staff to our fantastic school.

Year 1 Parents will receive a School Information Booklet as they have transitioned to the main school. If other parents would like a copy, it is available on the school website or from the office.

Student Early Arrivals

Primary students who arrive at school before 8.30am are to meet in the library. They will be supervised and dismissed to go to class at 8.30am. All classrooms open for students at 8.30am

Attendance

Regular school attendance has proven to make a difference to student achievement. If your son or daughter has one day away from class each week, they effectively lose nearly a whole term of learning. Over the Primary School years a child would lose over a whole year of school. Attendance matters as does punctuality. It is very disruptive and sometimes embarrassing for the student if they arrive after lessons commence. Please have your child at school and ready to join in lessons by 8.45am

Connect School Community

This year we will become a Connect School. Staff and students have been using Connect for lessons and communication. The whole school will use Connect for various forms of communication and for student reports.

Connect is a secure online environment developed by the Department of Education for staff, students and parents in public schools. It will give our teachers a tool to deliver content to the students via an online classroom. This means your children will be able to share with you what they are learning about, submit assignments and discuss issues together online anywhere, anytime. For you, Connect provides easy access to information relevant to your child's classes and learning such as assessments, teacher feedback and attendance data.

Schools can use Connect to keep you updated with important information. Things like up-coming events, excursions, classroom activities, photos and stories can be sent to you via email or push notification on your phone. Download Connect Now from the Apple App Store or Google Play to receive phone notifications.

You will soon receive your secure login information to Connect via the email address we have on file for you. If you have recently changed your email address, please let us know by phoning 9370 2900 or emailing Inglewood.PS@education.wa.edu.au so we can update your details.

When dropping and picking up students please be aware of, and respect the residents in the streets adjacent to the school and not park on their verges or in driveways.


As stated in the City of Stirling Parking Rules: Verge parking
