## COVID-19 Considerations

As we are holding our camp at a Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries run camp, you can be assured that all the relevant precautions and checks are in place.

The following measures are recommended by the Department of Education in accordance with the Health Department recommendations.

- There is a range of measures that can be undertaken in camp environments to reduce the risk of transmission.
- Maintaining good personal hygiene practices, including frequent hand washing, will be embedded in all activities.
- Student attendance at camps is at the parent/caregiver's discretion.
- Students with chronic medical conditions should seek medical advice prior to attending a school camp.
- All current Department of Education policies with regard to visitors to school sites apply in the camp environment.
- All current Department of Education policies in relation to camps and outdoor activities apply.
- All Department of Education guidelines in relation to protecting school communities from COVID-19 apply.
- Encourage good hygiene practices including regular hand washing with soap and water for 20 seconds or using hand sanitiser.
- Ensuring frequent and appropriate cleaning and disinfection of camp facilities. Cleaning must be undertaken each day of camp activity.

## COVID-19 RISK MANAGEMENT PLAN

- Your child needs to be well prior to leaving for camp.
- If your child is a household close contact when we are due go to camp, they should not attend.
- If your child starts to show symptoms of COVID-19, you will be contacted and required to come and collect your child, so that they can be tested.
- Camp provider has provided their COVID-19 Safety Plan Certificate in support of the school's risk management planning.
- We will take an adequate amount of facemasks for students who might become symptomatic.
- There is a plan in place for additional staff to be on stand-by in case a staff member shows symptoms.
- Alternative sleeping arrangements have been organised for if a student becomes symptomatic during the night.

**Arrangements Whilst On Camp:**

If you need to make contact with us while on camp, ring the school on 9223 9900 or contact Ern Halliday on 9492 9788 and a message will be passed on.

**Staff Action In Case Of Accident Or Illness Whilst On Camp:**

Staff accompanying students will take all reasonable measures while the students are in their care to protect them from injury and to control and supervise their behaviour and activities.

If your child becomes ill or is involved in an accident which requires medical attention, they will be accompanied by a staff member to a doctor or hospital.

If your child requires ANY medical services while away, you will be contacted immediately.

**Electrical Equipment:**

Children are **not permitted** to bring mobile phones, cameras, iPads, electronic music or game machines for entertainment while on camp. They are **not permitted** to bring portable DVD players or EBooks.

**Money:** Spending money is not needed on camp as there is nowhere to spend it; all activities and food are covered by camp costs.

**Lollies:** The children are **NOT** to bring lollies on camp.

**Medication:**

Those children who require any medication **MUST** be well aware of their routine and able to manage it personally. Please complete a medication form available from the office for any medication required whilst on camp.

**Packing:**

When assisting your child to pack their belongings for camp, please keep in mind that your child will be responsible for **CARRYING THEIR OWN BAG**. Please ensure that the bag your child brings is of a size and weight that they can carry themselves. **NO SUITCASES.**

**ALL** items brought on camp are the student's responsibility and should be **CLEARLY LABELLED**.

**Requirements:**

- Sleeping bag or bedding

- Hat
- Drink Bottle
- Small backpack or school bag
- Comfortable clothes for in camp activities – clothes that your child can easily move in. Please include one set of clothes suitable for caving (long sleeve top and long pants, as they will be crawling on their hands and knees).
