- Year to date there has been 6 Board meetings held. Items covered but not limited to, included reviewing the Annual School Budget and monitoring actuals to budget throughout the year, approving 2019 contributions, charges and personal items lists and approving of any new or amended policies.
- Following the successful first independent review of the School in 2017 as an independent school, a new Development and Performance Agreement (DPA) was entered into between the School and the Department of Education. Following this, and using feedback from the Department of Education on our 2017 Review, a new business plan was developed for the three year period 2018- 2020. The business plan's targets and strategies are presented, discussed and reviewed at each meeting with contributions from staff and board included in the review document.
- During the previous year, the Board prepared a new School Board Terms of Reference to replace the previous Constitution of the School Board, to reflect the unincorporated status of the Board.
