2021 year in review

- The Board welcomed 3 new members this year:

 - Teaching representative - Sherydne Sawyer
- The Board sincerely thanks the contribution to the Board and to the School to members whose term with the Board ended this year.
- Year to date 5 Board meetings have been held, along with representatives of the School Board attending the School Review. Items covered but not limited to, include reviewing the Annual School Budget and monitoring actuals to budget throughout the year, approving 2022 contributions, charges and personal items lists, reviewing and discussions on the School's 2021-2024 business plan and advising on any new or proposed amendments to existing policies, including the BYOD policy. The Statement of Expectation 2021-2024 was also noted by the Board.
- The Board completed the five-module board training program provided by the Department of Education.
- A new out of hours care provider was endorsed by the Board in Term 3 2021 with the provider, KidsCo, commencing in September.
- The Board endorsed voluntary P&C contributions to be added to the 2022 contributions, charges and personal items lists to assist the P&C to mitigate the impact of COVID-19 on fund raising activities over the past 2 years.
- The School with the Board went through the School Review process, which involved reviewers attending the School to spend time with school staff, parents, school children and the Board. The review identified a number of commendations and recommendations. Areas for focus over the next 12-months include the Relationships and Partnerships, and Leadership domains. The Board is working with the School on an improvement plan in preparation for a review of the Relationships and Partnerships and Leadership domains in Term 3 2022.
