Dear Parents and/or Caregivers,

As a school community we are working to support our families in their decision to self-isolate, keep sick children home or withdraw their children as a precaution to Covid-19. In doing so, we have created documents for at-home learning aimed at individual year levels. These work packages include a range of curriculum subjects; however, they focus on the Mathematics and English learning areas with suggested daily and weekly activities.

Students are able to also take home their Origo Stepping Stones and mental maths books. Please use the information sent home by the classroom teacher regarding appropriate activities and corresponding page numbers to complete. It is very important that students do not go ahead in these books as they are taught in specific sequences according to individual teacher planning throughout the year.

The Department of Education has advised schools that *'students whose parents have chosen to keep them home, without seeking medical advice, may not be provided curriculum work and activities. The priority for staff is to maintain focus on classroom learning programs. In the event of a temporary school closure, further advice will be provided.'*
